Dear Students and Family Members:

California Early College Academy (CECA) is a **college readiness pathway** that gives students the opportunity to learn both the academic and character skills necessary to be successful in college. Furthermore, when students demonstrate college readiness in the CECA Program, a pathway is provided by **American River College (ARC)** to take college courses. CECA students participate in an **early college program** that culminates with a **real college experience** that is built into the student's high school day. At no financial cost to the student.

An added benefit of the California Early College Academy is the opportunity for students to earn high school and college credit **simultaneously**, without the need for transportation to an off-site location. The CECA Program is structured so that students will have the opportunity to graduate with upwards to a full year of **UC/CSU transferable college credits** without having to leave the campus grounds.

American River College (ARC) is dedicated to the success of our CECA students. In addition to providing ARC college courses, ARC also provides academic counseling, college preparation and registration, specifically designed college courses, and a **pathway to acceptance and success at 4-year colleges and universities.**

CECA's ARC Counselor is oftentimes heard saying that "CECA is different from any other program because CECA students are considered college proven, not just college ready, in the eyes of universities and colleges."

CECA students are in cohorts with other CECA students, taught by trained CECA teachers.

Things to consider before applying to the California Early College Academy at Inderkum High School:

- ❖ Do you want a true college readiness program developed in partnership with college professors and deans?
- ❖ Do you want to be in a safe learning environment centered on college preparation in cohorts of CECA students?
- ❖ Do you want to have the opportunity to graduate high school with a year of college courses completed at ARC?
- ❖ Do you want to be considered college proven by the best four-year colleges and universities?
- ❖ Do you want to have access to ARC courses developed to make students effective writers and readers?
- ❖ Do you want access to an ARC Counselor for academic and course load counseling?
- ❖ Do you want to be mentored by successful college students in the CECA Program?
